



COMPREHENSIVE PLAN Fact Sheet

The City of La Vista is updating its Comprehensive Plan, the first such update since 1997, which will provide a big picture perspective on the City's future and will establish strategic goals for the long-term future of La Vista.

What is Look Out La Vista?

Look Out La Vista is an open and authentic process of updating the City's Comprehensive Plan. It is an opportunity for the community to address new challenges that lie ahead and serve as a guide for the City's approach to these challenges.

The Comprehensive Plan is the primary policy document for the community and the process of updating it will culminate in a long-term strategic plan. It will set forth a guiding vision and strategies to shape decisions related to new development, redevelopment, as well as city programs and services.

The City has long prided itself on long-term planning, which can serve as an influence and guide to produce the kind of community in the future of which we can all be proud.

Why does it matter?

The Comprehensive Plan is designed to be used by anyone interested in the future of La Vista, and can be useful in different ways to different groups:

- Residents may be interested in the location of planned parks, trails, or community facilities.
- Business and property owners may be interested in land use recommendations or development policies for their property.
- Decision-makers will use the Comprehensive Plan as a guide to inform the budget, timing for capital improvements, and in review of development proposals.

How can I get involved?

The success of Look Out La Vista is based on wide and diverse input. Residents can **sign up online** to join our contact list and receive notifications of upcoming events, or **read updates** in the CityWise quarterly newsletter.

In addition to open houses, workshops and social events, there will also be a strong online presence, including continuous questionnaires throughout the process, competitions, and opportunities to review information and provide comments directly to city staff.
