



# MOBILE FOOD VENDORS

## LICENSE INFORMATION

### License Required

Per Section 113.11 of the La Vista Municipal Code, mobile food vendors operating within the City of La Vista are required to have a current mobile food vending license.

To obtain a license, complete the application at [CityofLaVista.org/MobileFoodVendors](http://CityofLaVista.org/MobileFoodVendors), and submit the completed application and supplemental paperwork to the City Clerk's Department, 8116 Park View Blvd, La Vista, NE 68128.

The application review process takes approximately 20 business days.

### License Fee & Renewal

The license fee is \$100. Licenses are valid from January 1 to December 31, and they must be renewed annually.

### Hours of Operation

Licensed mobile food vendors may operate seven days a week from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. During non-hours of operation, a mobile food vendor motor vehicle or trailer shall not remain on any property on which sales have taken place.

### Locations of Operation

For allowable vending locations and restrictions, please refer to Ordinance No. 1396 and Section 113.11 of the La Vista Municipal Code.

Mobile food vending vehicles are not allowed to operate on City-owned property.

### Mobile Food Vending Vehicle

A mobile food vending motor vehicle shall not exceed 40 feet in length and 96 inches in width. If vehicle has an attached trailer or other auxiliary equipment, the combined length shall not exceed 60 feet, and the width shall not exceed 96 inches.

### Restaurant Tax

Mobile food vendors operating within the City of La Vista are subject to the Restaurants and Drinking Places Occupation Tax. For more information on this tax and remittance forms, visit [CityofLaVista.org/Restaurants](http://CityofLaVista.org/Restaurants).
