BID AWARD – FLUORESCENT LIGHTING REPLACEMENT-PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY EECBG AWARD No. 9/10-E062	◆ RESOLUTION ORDINANCE RECEIVE/FILE	JOHN KOTTMANN CITY ENGINEER/ASST. PW DIRECTOR

**SYNOPSIS**

A resolution has been prepared to award a contract to Omaha Electric Service, Omaha, Nebraska for replacement of fluorescent lighting tubes and ballasts in the Public Works Facility with more energy efficient products. This bid is for furnishing and installing the materials.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

Funding will come from a grant from the U.S. Department of Energy and the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Grant No. EECBG Award No. 9/10-E062. A local share is required in the amount of 20 percent of the project total. The FY 11/12 budget does not include funding for the local share for this project. Savings from another line item within Public Works will cover the project.

**BACKGROUND**

On November 15, 2011, the City Council approved a resolution which approved an amendment to the EECBG Aid Agreement to utilize the balance of the awarded grant funds for additional LED lighting modules for traffic signals and for replacement of the fluorescent lighting tubes and ballasts in the Public Works Facility. Bids were solicited from five electrical contractors and two bids were received as set forth on the attached tabulation. Omaha Electric Service was the low bidder in the amount of \$16,134.60. This low bid exceeded the amount of funds available in the remainder of the grant. The low bidder has agreed to eliminate enough fixtures from the contract to bring the cost within available funds. The amount of the contract will be \$12,779.82 after the reduction in the number of fixtures. Omaha Electric Service is a qualified contractor and has proposed to supply materials in compliance with the specifications. It is recommended that a contract be awarded to them in an amount not to exceed \$12,779.82.

The bidding results are summarized as follows:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VISTA, NEBRASKA, AWARDING A CONTRACT TO OMAHA ELECTRIC SERVICE, OMAHA NEBRASKA FOR REPLACEMENT OF FLOURESCENT LIGHTING TUBES AND BALLASTS IN THE PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$12,779.82.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of La Vista has determined that the replacement of existing fluorescent tubes and ballasts is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the funding will come from a grant from the U.S. Department of Energy and the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Grant No. EECBG Award No. 9/10-E062, and from saving in the FY 11/12 Public Works budget; and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2011, the City Council approved an amendment to the EECBG Aid Agreement to utilize the balance of the awarded grant funds for replacement of the fluorescent lighting tubes and ballasts in the Public Works facility, and

WHEREAS Omaha Electric Service of Omaha, Nebraska, has submitted the low, qualified bid, and

WHEREAS Subsection (C) (9) of Section 31.23 of the La Vista Municipal Code requires that the City Administrator secures Council approval prior to authorizing any purchase over \$5,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council of La Vista, Nebraska designate Omaha Electric Service, Omaha, Nebraska as the low qualified bidder for replacement of fluorescent lighting tubes and ballasts in the Public Works facility in an amount not to exceed \$12,779.82.
